
Hays County is studying possible route(s) for the development of a roadway that will extend RM 150 from RM 12 around the southwest side of Dripping Springs to connect to US 290.

THE STUDY AIMS TO:

- » Proactively plan for current and future traffic levels
- » Work with stakeholders and property owners during the planning process
- » Identify the footprint and right-of-way needs
- » Develop preliminary engineering plans (20% design) to inform budgeting and planning for future transportation needs



BACKGROUND:

Previous studies identified this needed connection.

- » Hays County Transportation Plan
 - 2013 plan identified needed connection at Roger Hanks Parkway
 - 2021 draft plan identifies needed connection further west
- » RM 150 Character Plan
 - Completed in 2017, identified preference for roundabout at RR 12 and RM 150
- » City of Dripping Springs Transportation Master Plan 2014 and 2018
 - Identifies a possible connection at Holder Lane and 290
